SUPERNUMERARY set the pressured pace off of the inside, was headed midway through the turn, fought back gamely, shook off TREETOP FLYER inside the furlong marker and edged clear. TREETOP FLYER tracked five wide, forged a brief lead near the five-sixteenths pole, was unable to match strides with the winner but was clearly the best of the rest. RAINING MOOLAH broke slow, settled toward the inside, shifted out leaving the turn, angled back to the inside and improved position. DALAMAN was forwardly placed four wide through the turn and faded. NEWS BOX contended between horses, dropped off of the leaders on the turn and showed little thereafter. ACES AND EIGHTS disputed the pace between rivals, but tired before going a half. CHARLIE DE HUSTLE was never a factor.
