**Footnotes**

HAWAAKOM saved ground on the first turn, settled towards the rear, raced inside on the far turn, swung five wide into the stretch, dropped in at the three-sixteenths then was roused, moved back out at the furlong marker and closed strongly to get up late. TARPY'S GOAL went three then two wide on the first turn, settled in the middle of the field, came between horses while in the two path on the far turn, swung four wide into the stretch, rallied in the final furlong, closed well to make a bid late but missed while able to get the place. THE SANDMAN set the pace on the inside through moderate fractions, was asked at the quarter-pole, came under the whip in upper stretch, led into the final sixteenth but was overtaken while clear for the show. COIN BROKER went three wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, saved ground on the far turn, swung four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. TOUGH CUSTOMER was reluctant to load, raced in the two path on the first turn, was well placed just off the pace, came under urging while inside on the far turn, was asked for his best in upper stretch and weakened. LATE NIGHT LU raced inside on the first turn, lagged near the back, was urged along while inside early on the far turn, came off the rail at the five-sixteenths and failed to threaten. COMMANDING CURVE went four wide on the first turn, raced near the back, was urged along while three wide early on the far turn, moved to the five path coming to the five-sixteenths, swung seven wide into the stretch and was no factor. ACES HIGH went two to three wide on the first turn, prompted the pace on the outside, chased in the two path on the far turn and tired. PRADO U raced in the two path on the first turn, settled on the outside, advanced four then three wide on the far turn, chased into upper stretch then came up empty. ETRUSCAN went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, dropped back while three wide early on the far turn then moved to the four

path, shifted six wide into the stretch and had nothing left.
