WILDCAT WISH stalked the early pace from the outside, steadily advanced up the backstretch, reached a striking position entering the second turn, responded when asked and wore down rivals the final yards. BLACK BEAR broke sharp from the outside, gained a clear early margin, remained clear up the backstretch, continued to show the way through the second turn, remained clear at the eighth pole but was caught the final jump. THE TRUTH OR ELSE outrun early, advanced outside up the backstretch, responded entering the second turn and closed with a rush for the show. SOUTHERN BARBECUE forced the early pace from the outside, advanced closer entering the second turn but had nothing for the drive. AARON'S BLUFF chased the early pace and tired. ACES HIGH was no threat. I CAME TO PARTY chased the early pace and faded. ZARB'S GIFT had a steady fade. J J BRAZZ showed little.
