CHOCOLATE RIDE raced in the five path early on the first turn then dropped to the three path, stalked the pace on the outside, chased in the two path on the far turn, took over into upper stretch and drew away under steady urging while keeping a close eye on the loose horse in front of him. STORMY PACIFIC went four wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along in the two path on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch and secured the place while no match for the winner. HUMOR saved ground on the first turn, settled towards the back, was asked in the two path on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch, bumped with SENOR BLANCO near the furlong marker and just got up for the show. SENOR BLANCO went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while five wide on the far turn, drifted inward in upper stretch, raced alongside of HUMOR into the final furlong, bumped with that foe near the sixteenth-pole and just missed the show. ACES HIGH was hustled from the start, raced in the three then two path on the first turn, set the pace, vied inside on the far turn, lost the advantage into upper stretch and weakened. MR. GARY D went around the first turn in the two path, settled off the pace, was roused in the three path on the far turn and failed to rally. IRISH PROSPECTOR was restless in the gate, settled on the inside, was

urged along on the far turn and failed to respond. HEAT FLASH went three wide on the first turn, settled in third position, was urged along in the four path on the far turn, dropped back while five wide into the stretch and capitulated. CHICAGO BLUES reared badly at the start and unseated the rider but was walked off. Following a stewards' inquiry into the incident at the start, no change was made to the order of finish. (Rail at 18 Feet)
