STREET CHIEF trailed the field early, swung into the six path in the far turn with a mild gain in the stretch run. ACES HIGH stalked the pace early, shifted into the three path in the far turn and weakened late in the stretch drive. HALL OF FAME was through after a half. SIGNAL HILL set the pace for a half then folded up. B STREET BLUES was done early.
