JERALD broke out and brushed with a rival, recovered quickly to contest the early lead while off the rail, dropped to the inside entering the backstretch, set the pace through solid fractions, inched clear outside the half-mile pole, easily shook off a brief bid by PORT AGGREGATE at the five-sixteenths, responded well when set down in upper stretch, drew off under a left-handed whip into the final furlong, continued under the whip until near the sixteenth-pole then was hand ridden to the wire while much the best. PORT AGGREGATE contested the early pace on the inside, was eased back off the pace late on the first turn, moved out early on the backstretch then tracked the leader, was asked while two to three wide on the far turn, made a brief bid at the five-sixteenths and proved no match for the winner while clear for the place. ACES HIGH went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, jostled with SPRINGBOARD outside the half-mile pole, was urged along while three to four wide on the far turn, brushed with the aforementioned rival near the five-sixteenths, was put to the whip in upper stretch and came up empty while best of the rest. SPRINGBOARD settled while off the inside, jostled with ACES HIGH outside the half-mile pole, was urged along in the two path on the far turn, brushed with the aforementioned rival at the five-sixteenths, was put to the whip in upper stretch and weakened. VICTORY COLORS settled at the back while on the inside, came off the rail early on the final turn and failed to threaten. SCOUT LEADER raced off the rail on the first turn, lagged at the back, was urged along while two to three wide on the far turn and showed little. SORPRESA D'ORO brushed with a rival at the start, went three wide on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, dropped in leaving the backstretch, came up empty along the rail on the final turn and stopped.
