FEAR THE COWBOY broke in good order, allowed the two leaders to go into the first turn, settled in the second flight in the two path, made a clever move to challenge three wide midway on the second turn, narrowly showed the way into the stretch, inched out to a larger advantage past the furlong marker then held the runner up safe late under firm handling. GREAT MINDS tracked the pace from along the inside, lost some position as the leader made his move in the second turn, switched out for the drive, set down, slowly getting to that same foe late. ACES HIGH pressured the early leader from the outside, moved up to duel with that rival the middle half, vied between foes into the lane, could not match the winner to the wire nor could he contain the runner up while proving stubborn until late. THE PICKETT FACTOR took control along the inside into the first turn, helped set a soft set of internal fractions, did not have much left for the stretch run. GRIT last away, trailed in failing to threaten.
