ACES HIGH was steadied shortly after the break heading into the first turn, shifted out, pressed the pace three wide along the backstretch, edged clear nearing the three sixteenths pole and prevailed. AIRLITE was away alertly, set the pace along the backstretch, battled with ACES HIGH to the furlong marker but failed to match strides late and was second best. CHARLIE WEBB was reserved on the inside through the half, swung four wide on the far turn and closed belatedly widest of all. GLACKEN'S GHOST pressed the pace three wide through the half and gave way on the far turn. ROCKET JOE COPPER tracked the pace between foes throughout and failed to menace in the lane. HOLIDAY MISCHIEF tracked the pace on the rail throughout and faltered in the lane.
