**Footnotes**

ACES HIGH was rated along the inside in the opening stages tracking just off the first flight under light reserve, shifted a bit off the rail after a half, then three wide leaving the midway point of the far turn while being prompted to advance, bid for command between foes in that path leaving midstretch and edged forward to prevail under strong handling. TEDDY TIME was settled while angling nearer to the inside racing to the backstretch, split foes just off the inside gathering momentum nearing upper stretch, then shifted four in late stages while finishing willingly to prevail for the place honors. QUALITY INDEED sped to the fore while angling to the rail, dictated the pace on a narrow margin along the inside to the far turn, turned back rivals to regain a clear advantage in upper stretch but yielded to the top pair in late stages. ALPINE GATHERING, three deep in the second flight early, was eased off the second flight to track the leaders outside a rival to the backstretch, advanced four wide, then five wide nearing upper stretch steadily gaining position into the stretch and was just outkicked for a share. RED ZONE angled to the inside early to track just off the second flight, saved ground to upper stretch steadily gaining position into the lane but was outkicked. CHARLIE AGAIN came through close quarters in the opening stages to gain a position in the second flight, shifted out, three, then four wide into the far turn to lodge a brief bid but soon flattened out. CHARLIE WEBB settled outside foes in the last flight racing to the backstretch and offered no rally. VINO LIMBO TANGO was urged to terms prompting a rival's pace racing to the backstretch, pressed the issue through the far turn and gave way into upper stretch.
