## **Footnotes**

MAJESTIC PRIDE was rated inside foes in second flight tracking the leaders from just out of striking distance in the opening half, shifted out nearing upper stretch, was prompted to split foes three wide in upper stretch and produced a solid late response to wrest the advantage in time under firm handling. IBAKA, urged to the fore while angling to the rail on the first turn, disputed the pace inside foes into the second turn, edged forward leaving midstretch but just failed to contain the winner. HAY DAKOTA was settled last along the inside in the opening quarter, switched out midway through the backstretch while continuing under light reserve, was prompted to advance splitting foes while swinging out five wide racing into upper stretch and finished willingly in that path to close the gap on the top pair. SIGHTFORSOREEYES, a bit wide into the first turn, gained a forward placing three deep attending the pace racing to the second turn, was urged to challenge in that path racing into upper stretch but was outkicked between rivals in the closing stages. HIGH SECURITY tracked off the second flight between foes in the opening half, shifted out four wide racing into upper stretch while being prompted to advance and continued with a mild bid between rivals. LAWLESS WEST, urged to terms forcing the pace outside a rival racing into the backstretch, dueled for command into upper stretch and weakened in the last furlong. CHIEF KNOW IT ALL tracked off the second flight inside foes to the far turn but offered no rally. ACES HIGH angled inwards in the opening stages to track the pace outside a rival in the second flight, continued between foes into the far turn and steadily faded nearing the lane. CONSUMERCONFIDENCE, unhurried outside foes tracking off the second flight in the opening half, steadily retreated on the far turn.
