

PROFLUENT bumped with BLUEGRASS SPRINGS at the start, was urged along on the outside, raced in the two path on the turn, shifted three wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside, took the lead entering the final furlong then edged clear under good handling. ROCKIN BOOGIE settled off the pace, lugged out while under some restraint late on the backstretch into the turn, remained in hand while towards the inside on the bend, moved out after finally being asked near the three-sixteenths and finished with good energy but was too late. BATTEN THE HATCHES settled off the pace, was urged along while three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch, chased in the drive and finished willingly for the show. COPPERPLATE disputed the pace on the inside, vied along the rail on the turn, bumped with BROTHER JIMMY RAY while under a drive in upper stretch and weakened then lost the show. BLUEGRASS SPRINGS bumped with PROFLUENT at the start, showed no speed, went two then three wide on the turn, swung five wide into the stretch, drifted in approaching the furlong marker and lacked the needed response. BROTHER JIMMY RAY contested the pace on the outside, vied in the two path on the turn, bumped with COPPERPLATE while under a drive in upper stretch and tired. CHA MONO showed speed between horses, dropped back after cocking his head to the outside near the half-mile pole, raced inside on the turn, moved out in upper stretch and came up empty. CAPTAIN MARVIN was ridden along at the rear of the field, raced near the inside on the turn, swung four wide into the stretch and failed to threaten.
