#### Footnotes

DA BIG HOSS was rated between horses in the two path on the first turn, made his way to the outside midway down the backstretch, ranged up while three wide on the far turn, took the lead inside the quarter-pole, turned into the stretch under a left-handed whip, inched clear into the final furlong and proved best under strong urging. MUTASAAWY broke a bit slow, raced off the rail on the first turn, was unhurried at the rear, advanced three then four wide on the far turn, chased into upper stretch, drifted out under a left-handed whip, switched to a right-handed whip outside the sixteenth marker and was second best. DUSTIN'S PASSION raced in the two path on the first turn, disputed the pace, dropped back with five furlongs to run, drafted inside early on the far turn, came off the rail with a quarter-mile to run, was put to a drive into the stretch, chased the top two and was outfinished while able to get the show. SORPRESA D'ORO was rated inside on the first turn, settled on the backstretch, was urged along while two then three wide early on the far turn, moved to four wide late on that bend and failed to rally. COPPERPLATE went three wide on the first turn, disputed the pace on the outside, moved clear with five furlongs to run, vied inside on the far turn, lost the lead inside the guarter-pole, dropped back under a drive in upper stretch and gave way. CHOCOLATE RIDE was rank off heels approaching the first turn, went three wide on that bend, tracked the pace, chased two to three wide on the far turn and came up empty.
