MOUNT CALVARY raced a three wide trip to the turn, shifted four wide into stretch and rallied all out to be along in time at the wire. EN HANSE inside to quarter pole, shifted off rail, led to last jump and was nosed in a heart break defeat at the wire. SON OF A NUT vied between horses all the way and was outfinished to the wire. KISS MY NOTE never far back off rail to the turn, shifted inside through the final furlong to no avail. MOOSE vied three wide to quarter pole but gave way in the stretch run. ALL HANSENS ONDECK bothered after the star and, raced wide throughout with no late gain. HERE'S CARLOS never a real menace. COPPERPLATE saved ground to no avail throughout.
