CHAMPIONS GATE dueled on the lead the entire trip from the rail, was well handled in the drive, dug in gamely late and prevailed. RUNNIN FUN dueled on the lead with the winner throughout, held gamely and just missed. GOT GRIT was unhurried early, swung wide in the stretch and had a mild bid. TORAZO never far back, lost ground on the turn and went evenly. MOVING STYLE raced mid pack and went evenly. TEAM SIX had good position early, lacked a late response. PUERTO PLATA contended early, then tired. TIGER TANK was well placed until the top of the stretch, lacked a late bid. TREVOR JOHN was outrun. COPPERPLATE broke slowly and was outrun.
