Footnotes

VOODOO SPELL settled off the pace, went around the turn in the two path, swung four wide into the stretch, rallied quickly on the outside, closed fast to get the lead outside the furlong marker, drew clear under urging into the final sixteenth then was eased up late while much the best. BATTEN THE HATCHES was well placed just off the pace, raced inside on the turn, lacked room behind opponents in upper stretch, moved out after being asked at the three-sixteenths and safely secured the place. BLUEGRASS SPRINGS was coaxed along while just off the pace, chased three wide on the far turn and weakened while able to get the show. COPPERPLATE pressed the pace, dropped back leaving the backstretch, raced inside on the turn, lacked room behind horses from the quarter-pole to the eighth-pole, came under urging at that point, hesitated while blocked briefly at the sixteenth-pole and lost any chance at a better position. SORPRESA D'ORO pressed the pace on the outside, chased two to three wide on the turn, came under the whip in upper stretch and tired. BROTHER JIMMY RAY set the pace under pressure, inched clear while off the rail on the turn, came under a drive in upper stretch, lost the lead to the winner and gave way. AGAVE CAT was reserved off the pace, went four wide while under urging on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and failed to rally. VETER (FR) was urged along near the back, raced in the two path on the turn, moved out in upper stretch and failed to threaten. CADILLAC BAR settled at the back, saved ground on the turn and was no factor. (Rail at 15 Feet)
