COPPERPLATE shadowed the leaders four wide, took over midway through the turn, shook clear entering the stretch and widened. SAINT PRADO was unhurried into stride, got through between horses entering the stretch and closed well for the place. CLASSIC SALSA vied for the lead between horses, exchanged bumps with NITE OF THE HUNTER near the seven-sixteenths pole, kept on well to the stretch, was unable to match strides with the winner, then failed to preserve the runner up spot. NITE OF THE HUNTER was close up between runners, was jostled entering the turn and steadied, was quickly back into stride but went evenly thereafter. PESKY CAT was allowed to settle four wide but lacked a response when called upon. BOURBON CANDY set the pressured pace off of the inside, was bumped into the turn, contested the issue to the stretch and caved. BLACK TAVISH was rank to place and was never a factor.
