SAINT PRADO settled in hand, came six wide to make his bid, forged a late lead and was fully extended to just last. FOURTH OF JULY was allowed to settle, came seven wide, closed with a rush but wasn't quite able to bridge the gap. MELLOW FELLOW tracked five wide, took over leaving turn, continued on well but grudgingly gave in. COPPERPLATE settled saving ground, angled out leaving the turn and improved position. SWIFT ONE contended off of the inside but failed to make headway. PESKY CAT broke slow, finished with a belated gain but was never a factor. MOOOSE broke through the gate, contested the pace three wide, but faltered between runners leaving the turn and faded. FOURTH AND CENTRAL failed to respond. BLACK TAVISH was away alertly, set the pressured pace toward the inside for a half and dropped out. THE LAST PROPHET showed little.
