Footnotes

COPPERPLATE chased the pace from the three path through the turn, was asked for more while straightening in the lane, caught the leaders inside the eighth pole then drove past. WINGS LOCKED UP set the pace into the turn while under pressure from the inside, dispatched that challenger inside the eight pole, was joined by another, fought gamely to inside of the sixteenth pole then could not hold off the winner. VBREEZE pressed the pace from along the inside into the lane, was still a serious contender inside the eighth pole then weakened. STEVIS MAN was well off the inside while unhurried through the turn, came into the lane from mid-track then offered a belated gain. RULE THE WAR was in the three or four path through the turn while in contention then lacked a response through the lane. LAWYER CHARLES was still in contention moving into the turn while off the inside then tired thereafter. AWESOME HEAT broke slowly then trailed throughout.
