HIDDEN CANDY chased the pace early, swung into the six path in the turn, made a bid, drove past the leaders in the stretch and cleared the field in the late stages. CHESTER'S PARK dueled early between horses, shifted into the four path in the turn and yielded late in the stretch run. GO VO ran erratic through the turn, angled to the inside in the stretch and moved up late. COPPERPLATE dueled for the lead early from the inside, shifted into the three path in the turn and faltered late in the stretch drive. RHYTHM PARK was bumped and bothered early, swung into the six path in the turn and was empty late. WINDSURFER improved position. DOWNTOWN COWBOY vied for the lead early three wide, was bumped and bothered inside the three sixteenth pole and folded up. BATTEN THE HATCHES was never a factor.
