Footnotes

COUNTY CORRECTIONS tracked the pace three wide, forged command with a furlong to run, and held sway under stern urging. FORFEIT was allowed to settle off of the inside, split horses a furlong from home, finished full of run and was gaining with every stride. INDIANO JONES was allowed to settle, moved up five wide, was bumped near the three-eighths pole when PROSECUTION came out and again with a quarter to run when that foe came out again, kept on well to make a bold bid but was unable to bridge the gap. PROSECUTION contended between horses, bumped INDIANO JONES midway through the turn and again entering the stretch, loomed a danger but weakened slightly. YARDBIRD MISFITS was allowed to settle, came five wide and improved position. ROCKIN BOOGIE contended off of the inside, shifted off five wide leaving the turn, but weakened between horses and faded. COPPERPLATE opened clear and angled in to set the pace, was headed nearing the furlong marker and gave way. TEN INDIAN passed only the tiring ones. AZTEC BRAVE (FR) steadied between horses down the hill, moved up to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. PARTY TIME steadied early, was shuffled back and showed little thereafter. CHA MONO was close up along the inside to the final furlong and wilted.
