## Footnotes

REIMBURSE was rated just off the pace on the inside under a snug hold, drafted behind the leader while still in hand on the far turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, came under a drive in upper stretch, moved out at the furlong marker, rallied to the lead at the sixteenth-pole then powered clear under good handling. SISTER BLUES saved ground on the first turn, settled nicely off the pace, rounded the far turn in the two path, waited behind horses from the quarter-pole to the three-sixteenths, found room and was roused at that point then finished with good energy to garner the place. BRISSON raced in the two path on the first turn, settled on the outside, was roused in the three path on the far turn, angled out in upper stretch and finished willingly for the show. SWEETBABY set the pace on the inside, was asked while in the two path at the quarter-pole, led under the whip into the final furlong, was collared at the sixteenth-pole then outfinished and caught for the show. COLLEGE HOLLY went three wide on the first turn, was reserved on the outside, raced four wide while let out on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed kick. TSUNAMI GIRL raced in the two path on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, was asked in the two path on the far turn, came three wide into the stretch, chased the leader into the final furlong and weakened. CLOSE THE GAP raced in the two path on the first turn, settled on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. (Rail at 25 Feet)
