Footnotes

ZINGER was bumped in the hindquarters just after the start, bumped with DON'T SPLIT TENS into the first turn, was well placed on the inside, came under urging in the two path on the far turn, was put to the whip coming to the quarter-pole, chased the runner-up into the final sixteenth and got up gamely at the wire. ELENZEE raced in the two path early on the first turn then dropped to the rail, set the pace, vied inside on the far turn, was asked after turning into the stretch, came under a left-handed whip at the furlong marker, led determinedly into the final sixteenth but was denied on the wire. UNTIMED PLAY settled at the back on the inside, saved ground behind horses on the far turn, was asked while turning into the stretch in the two path, angled out at the three-sixteenths and finished willingly to just get the show. DON'T SPLIT TENS came in at the start then bumped with a rival and was taken up a bit, pulled in the early going, bumped with ZINGER into the first turn, went three wide on that bend, settled on the backstretch, was urged along while two to three wide on the far turn, moved to the four path outside the quarter-pole, drifted inward in upper stretch and also finished willingly but just missed the show. FIRE COMMISSIONER bumped with foes just after the start, checked between horses nearing the first turn, went two to three wide on that bend, settled near the back, went two to three wide early on the far turn, was asked at the five-sixteenths then moved to the four path, floated six wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. SIR BALLANTINE went four then three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along in the two path on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and was no factor. HARMAC went four then three wide on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, was asked in the three path on the far turn, chased into upper stretch and came up empty. DIMATE settled on the inside, was urged along late on the backstretch, saved ground under stronger encouragement on the far turn and failed to respond. (Rail at 20 Feet)
