

MARCO MISCHIEF went three then two wide on the first turn, settled near the back, was roused in the three path on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and closed strongly to get up late. ZINGER raced in the two path on the first turn, settled just off the pace, was asked in the three path on the far turn, made a bid at the quarter-pole, battled gamely in the stretch, held the lead late but was denied. MIGHTY MANFRED went three wide early on the first turn, came out over heels then checked late on that bend, was reserved on the outside, advanced four wide on the far turn, made a bid at the quarter-pole, battled into the final sixteenth then was outfinished while just able to get the show. CHASING THE DREAM went three then two wide on the first turn, set the pace, vied inside on the far turn, was asked once straightened for the drive, battled with two opponents into the final sixteenth and was also outfinished but missed the show. FIRE COMMISSIONER raced near the inside on the first turn, settled towards the back, saved ground on the far turn, spun into the two path entering the stretch, moved out under a drive, gained between horses outside the sixteenth, came out over heels late and improved position. HARD TO IMPRESS saved ground on the first turn, settled off the pace, went two then three wide on the far turn and lacked the needed response. KALININGRAD went four wide early on the first turn, steadied late on that bend while forced out by MIGHTY MANFRED, settled in the middle of the field, was urged along in the two path on the far turn and failed to threaten. DYNAMITE MAN went three then two wide on the turns, came three wide into the stretch, was urged

between horses past the three-sixteenths and was no factor. DADDY'S PLACER went four then three wide on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, made a bid in the two path on the far turn, dropped back under the whip in upper stretch and gave way. ALL SPUN UP raced near the rail on the first turn, settled off the pace, saved ground on the far turn, steadied some in upper stretch and failed to respond. MISTER CORBIT raced near the rail on the first turn, was well placed just off the pace, chased inside on the far turn and capitulated.
