AUNTJENN set the pace early, angled off the rail in the turn, repelled bid into the lane, opened back up a clear advantage nearing the sixteenth pole and held sway in the final stages. SWING AND SWAY came in at the start, chased the pace early, fanned into the five path in the turn, made a bid in the stretch but did not have enough in the final stages. PERFECT WIFE was well placed early on, fanned into the seven path in the turn while making a bid but flattened out late in the stretch run. TOO MUCH TIP was bumped at the start, tracked the pace early, shifted into the four path in the turn and weakened late in the stretch drive. CARA BLYTHE was bumped at the start, steadied along the backstretch, fanned into the eight path in the turn and moved up in the stretch. MYTHICAL TALE angled off the rail in the turn and faded down the lane. NINETEENTH STREET came out at the start, fanned into the five path in the turn. MINNIE BLIP was through after a half.
