PUT DA BLAME ON ME set the pace early, was on the inside entering the lane, was under a long drive down the lane, came out and bumped foe but dug in and gamely prevailed in the final stages. MINES AND MAGIC stalked the pace early, shifted into the three path in the turn, was under a long drive down the lane, loomed large, was bumped and just missed at the wire. MISS MO KELLY trailed the field early on, shifted into the four path in the turn and moved up in the stretch run. FLEET BERTIE bobbed at the start, shifted into the four path in the turn and improved position in the stretch drive. SHES A TRUE BEAUTY chased the pace early, angled off the rail in the turn and was empty down the lane. NINETEENTH STREET tracked the pace early, angled off the rail in the turn and faded in the stretch. IMPASSE was through after a half.
