Footnotes

KING PTOLEMY was bothered early along, shifted into the three path in the far turn, rallied into the lane, made a bid in the stretch and edged past the leader in the final stages. SIMON BAR SINISTER came in a bit early along, set the pace, angled off the rail into the far turn, drew clear in the stretch but was caught in the late stages. MATCH UP was unhurried early, fanned into the five path in the far turn, rallied into the lane, made a bid in the stretch but did not have enough late. ROYAL WARRANT was bothered early, swung into the six path in the far turn, rallied into the lane and was gaining late in the stretch run. CLOVELLY tracked the pace early, shifted into the three path in the far turn and flattened out late in the stretch drive. CAR FIFTY FOUR swung into the six path in the far turn with some gain in the stretch. CHINA HOLIDAY was well placed early, shuffled back entering the stretch and moved up late. SERGIOS PRIDE was never a threat. MIZZ WIZZ was through after three quarters. DON'T HOLD ME BACK was bothered early, stalked the pace, angled off the rail into the far turn and was empty late.
