Footnotes

DARE TO BE settled off the pace while saving ground, angled four wide advancing into the lane, closed under right handed rousing, moved past the dueling leaders inside the sixteenth pole and edged clear late. SPANISH ROMANCE (IRE) was floated out a bit while prompting the pace entering the turn, pressed two wide past the five sixteenths, gained a slim lead after being set down in upper stretch, dueled, brushed with PLAY UNIFIED inside the eighth pole and kept on gamely to just get the place. CATCHING FIREFLIES rated towards the inside, eased out mid turn, worked between rivals in mid stretch, switched to her left lead and continued with interest while just missing second. PLAY UNIFIED sped to the front, drifted out a bit entering the turn, was corrected and set a pressured pace inside, ceded command in upper stretch, brushed with SPANISH ROMANCE dueling past the eighth pole and gave way grudgingly. STORM TEMPLE PILOT, away well, prompted the pace along the rail, had aim on the leaders in mid stretch but faded. DO WHAT I SAY broke sluggishly, was used wide to reach contention, chased three wide around the turn, remained in range to mid stretch then weakened. NASTAR MEDALLIST broke a bit slow, lost ground four and five wide pursuing the leaders and gave way.
