STORM TEMPLE PILOT broke sharply, was sent well clear of the field while angling to the inside, dictated terms on a commanding margin racing into the turn and held sway to the end under brisk handling. SEAMS DISCREET, urged between foes tracking the leader leading the second flight on a narrow margin into the turn, continued willingly between rivals to close the gap while prevailing for the place honors. FLASH N GO angled in tracking off the second flight racing into the turn, split foes just off the inside racing into upper stretch and was just outfinished for the place honors. TRINNI tracked the pacesetter three wide in second flight racing into the turn and continued to make mild progress in that path late. BELLA'S BACK settled last outside foes early, raced four, then five wide into upper stretch but made no impact. SHABOOM settled between foes off the second flight racing to the turn and never gained contention. ASTRAL FAVOR tracked off the second flight inside foes in early stages and steadily faded into the stretch. TA KELA WARNING was a brief factor inside foes in second flight but steadily retreated nearing the lane.
