HARLAN'S HOWLING stalked the pace early, fanned into the seven path in the turn, drove past the leader in the stretch and cleared the field in the final stages. TWENTY GAUGE pressed the pace early, swung into the six path in the turn, continued on down the lane but gave in late in the drive. MICHAEL was unhurried early, shifted into the four path in the turn and moved up in the stretch run. WARRIOR PRINCE set the pace early, shifted into the four path in the turn and faltered late in the stretch drive. CENTER POINTE was back early, fanned into the seven path in the turn and improved position in the stretch. CAPTAIN KITTEN fanned into the seven path in the turn and was empty late. MAXAINTASAINTE was never a threat. DEVADUTT was through after a half. OLD FASHION MILLER came in at the start and was done early. IT'S ROBIN steadied at the start.
