KAYLA'S KITTEN disputed the pace three wide, shook clear leaving the turn, and drew away to prove much the best. WARRIOR PRINCE stalked the pace in hand, ranged up four wide to make a mild bid, failed to menace the winner, had the rider lose the whip inside the furlong marker but stayed on to hold the place. COLT WESTON was unhurried into stride, circled into the stretch and was along for the show. MICHAEL broke slow, rushed to contention along the inside, but faltered entering the lane and faded. SILVER FORKED SKY contended early, tucked in on the turn to save ground, but lacked a response when called upon. FIVE BOYS failed to respond. KIM MAN vied for the lead along the inside for a half and stopped.
