ALBERT'S HOUR was back early, swung into the six path in the turn while making a bid but flattened out late in the drive. WARRIOR PRINCE stalked the pace early, angled off the rail in the turn and weakened late. MIXED COLORS trailed the field early, swung into the six path in the turn with a belated gain in the stretch. GOLDEN GIFT tracked the pace early, shifted into the three path in the turn and faded late. LAST PROSPECT was never a threat. NO HOLDEM POKER had early speed then folded up.
