HENDERSON COUNTRY trailed the field early, swung into the six path in the turn, rallied into the lane, made a bid in the stretch and rolled past the leader in the final stages. SHIP DISTURBER tracked the pace early, shifted into the three path in the turn, took over and inched clear in the stretch but was ran down in the final stages. WARRIOR PRINCE set the pace early, angled off the rail in the turn and faltered late in the stretch run. SUNSET SANDS chased the pace early, shifted into the four path in the turn and flattened out in the stretch drive. HALL O' GLORY stalked the pace early, fanned into the five path in the turn and weakened late in the stretch. DR. HAL was done early.
