WINNING NOTE set the pace through solid fractions, lost the lead at the quarter-pole, battled gamely with KIPTASTIC in the stretch and narrowly prevailed under strong urging. KIPTASTIC went two to three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, chased two to three wide on the far turn, made a bid at the quarter-pole, battled with WINNING NOTE in the stretch and just missed. SEEKING AN EMPIRE brushed with a rival at the start, went four then three wide on the first turn, lingered well back in the field, was ridden along while three then four wide on the far turn and finished with good energy for the show. WESTERN SADLER brushed with an opponent at the start, lagged at the rear of the field, saved ground while urged along on the far turn and improved position. RATION settled on the inside, was urged along on the far turn and lacked the needed response. KAMCHATKA settled off the pace, was ridden along while off the rail on the far turn and failed to respond. KEG PARTY went two then three wide on the first turn, settled on the inside of THAAATS RIGHT, was ridden along while three then two wide on the far turn and came up empty. THAAATS RIGHT went three then four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while four then three wide on the far turn and had nothing left.
