

SONG TO YOU lugged out early while showing speed, had TEN INDIAN clip his heels nearing the first turn, raced off the rail early on that bend then dropped to the inside, set the pace, was taken back when the loose horse came alongside him midway down the backstretch, relinquished the lead then lost position nearing the half-mile pole, drafted behind the loose horse and two other rivals on the far turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, made a bid along the rail when the loose horse came out, dueled with EMPIRE MAKER with the loose horse between them, inched clear into the final sixteenth under a drive then proved best while hand ridden late in a strange journey. EMPIRE TAKER bumped with TEN INDIAN early then was in tight quarters when that rival clipped heels, was rated while off the inside, jostled with LARGE SCALE early on the backstretch, ranged up while four then three wide on the far turn, made a bid at the five-sixteenths pole, came four wide into the stretch, dueled with SONG TO YOU while outside of the loose horse into the final furlong and was outfinished while able to get the place. 



SEVERE WEATHER went four then three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while three to four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. TURBALO brushed with a rival at the start, raced off the rail on the first turn, was unhurried at the rear, raced inside while ridden along on the far turn, angled out in upper stretch and failed to threaten. A STUDENT was off about two lengths slow, went three then four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, moved up near the half-mile pole, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, went wrong in upper stretch and was pulled up then vanned off.
