NO FREE LUNCH chased the pace on the outside then four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and secured the place while no match for the winner. BLUE Y GOLD (ARG) disputed the pace on the outside, vied three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and proved no match for the winner then lost the place while just able to hold the show. COUNTY CORRECTIONS was coaxed along on the outside, went four wide on the turn, came six wide into the stretch and just missed the show. SEEKING AN EMPIRE dropped back while urged along, raced inside on the turn, and failed to threaten. AMAZING AVERIATOR broke a bit slow, moved up then was well placed just off the pace, drafted behind the leader on the turn, was roused at the quarter-pole and failed to respond. SEVENOAKS broke a step slow, was urged along at the rear, went two then three wide on the turn and was no factor.
