BETWEENHEREANDCOOL rated just off the pace off the inside, moved to challenged far turn while between foes, shook clear, kept to task. ILLUSION CONFUSION well back off the pace, raced four wide into the lane, rallied, moved out late, up late for the place, no threat to the winner. SEEKING AN EMPIRE settled off the pace, four wide in the far turn, angled in drive, caught late for the place. EMPIRE TAKER settled in mid pace, ranged up five wide in the second turn, flattened out in the drive. DOWNTOWN GHOST void of early foot, came six wide out of the final turn, improved position while not a serious threat late. TONKAWA fell back after the start under restraint, lacked a significant late response. ONLY IN AMERICA was never a threat. INDIAN STYLE bumped at the start, within striking distance, came up empty for the drive. TUCKERS POINT prompted the pace while racing outside, had little left for the drive. ST. MARY'S COUNTY roughed at the start, was never close. MUTASADDER moved up, set the pace, gave way when headed far turn. TWISTED NOTION was finished early.
