



SEEKING AN EMPIRE moved to the inside to take over past the five eighths pole, rated the pace from that point, was pressured toward the three eighths, battled at even terms nearest the rail rounding the final turn and dug in under determined handling to discourage the efforts of Sweeping West. SWEEPING WEST stalked the pace two deep, challenged leaving the three eighths pole, contested at even terms rounding the final turn, dug in a game factor to mid-stretch but hung the last sixteenth. SURFING UP rated off the pace off the rail, bid between horses at the three eighths pole, rounded the final turn near the rail and finished evenly a close third. SHENANDOAH settled close five wide, bid leaving the three eighths pole then leveled off in the four path of the final turn. ERDENET rated close to the early pace four wide then leveled off rounding the final turn. WILKO BEER, off the pace outside, saved some ground weakening on the final turn. HAPPY HAROLD rated close to the early pace inside, raced hemmed at the heels of his stable-mate rounding the first turn, bid leaving the seven sixteenths pole then faded toward the final turn. WIDE EYED CLYDE came away a step slow, raced in the six path of the opening turn and never factored. ABANDONEDANDBROKE stumbled at the break then ran out the opening turn and never factored.
