Footnotes

TIZ NOW MY CHOICE contended between horses, angled to the inside midway through the second turn, slipped through entering the stretch, struck the lead with a furlong to run and edged clear. MASERATI (BRZ) was allowed to settle four wide, came five wide to make a bold bid, but was unable to match strides with the winner. LIFES REWARD attended the pace along the inside, got through and poked his head in front with three furlongs to run, drifted out a bit entering the stretch, was collared between horses and weakened during the drive. ENTRAINMENT settled saving ground within striking distance, angled out entering the stretch but faltered in the final furlong. SEEKING AN EMPIRE was reserved off of the pace, drew even between horses leaving the second turn, but flattened during the drive and faded. CHIEF WHITE FOX was close up four wide to the stretch and retreated. BELLODINI broke a step slow, pulled to the lead between horses, was headed nearing the three-eighths pole and gave way readily thereafter. FIRE FLIGHT broke awkwardly, was unhurried into stride, dropped far back after a half and trailed.
