NO WAY R J pressed the pace three wide, took the lead near the three-sixteenths pole, drew clear nearing the lane and widened under a drive. MR. RIPKEN dueled two wide between foes, could not match stride with the winner from the sixteenth pole but dug in to save the place. FAST PUNISHMENT chased the pace three and four wide, had a mild rally and just missed second. SEEKING AN EMPIRE lacked speed along the inside, angled out nearing the lane and rallied. CASANOVA CALLING chased the pace inside, angled three wide nearing the lane and lacked the needed rally. HIGHNTHESKYMERCURY broke awkwardly, was unhurried while far back inside, advanced while extremely wide around the far turn, came ten wide into the lane and rallied belatedly. RIP CURRENT dueled along the rail and tired in the drive. SIX STORMS never factored while racing three and four wide. THRTEYEGHTHAILMARYS was outrun while racing two wide.
