LITTLE BIG SIME stalked the pace four wide, took the lead near the quarter pole, angled in nearing the lane, dug in inside and led until the final strides. JAZZY'S QUATTRO stalked the pace two wide, rallied between foes through the lane and just missed. SEEKING AN EMPIRE was bumped just after the start, raced two wide and had a mild belated rally. MIDDLE OF WINTER was bumped just after the start, saved ground well back early, went three wide around the far turn and played no threat. COTTONWOOD WILL stalked the pace two wide, vied two wide down the backstretch and tired around the far turn. PIGEON CHRIS set the pace along the rail and faltered around the far turn. FIRST TASTE was bumped just after the start, saved ground and played no further factor. THREE MEN ON was bumped just after the start, raced two and three wide and was outrun.
