**Footnotes**

BROADWAY BREEZE close up along the inside, angled out for the drive, forged to the front in midstretch and held sway while drifting out late. DYANI outrun for a half, steadied and altered course out four wide with three furlongs to go, advanced in that path into the stretch and closed well late. ENGLISH GIRL reserved along the inside, moved off the rail when advancing on the second turn, steadied angling out four wide late on the second turn, then rallied willingly late. GRANDE BOLD outrun for a half three wide, made a good middle move along the inside, angled out for the drive then was in traffic late when the winner drifted out. DIXIE'S HOPE with the pace from the outset, took over before a half, led the field to the final furlong and faltered. BLUES LEGEND unhurried three wide, moved out a path with three furlongs to go then lacked a closing bid. JEWELRY (BRZ) reserved off the inside, made a run along the inside on the second turn but could not sustain the bid. CIRCLEBOUND BAY vied for the lead off the inside, held on well to the stretch and tired. WICKEDODOLOGY within striking distance, moved out to be three wide into the second turn, steadied once in that turn and tired. BEAUTIFUL SONG reserved for a half, took up from between rivals near the three furlong marker when WICKEDODOLOGY steadied then was no factor. DIZA forwardly placed three wide, moved in a path on the second turn and stopped.
