

KAMINARI was never far back while racing along the inside, angled out nearing the three-sixteenths marker, responded to aggressive handling and wore down PRETTY NOT through the closing yards. PRETTY NOT dueled for the lead from the inside with AMAZING SAINT, disposed of that rival with a furlong to run, opened a clear margin but could not hold the winner safe late. MINESAVE was bumped at the start, raced off the pacesetters from the inside, angled out nearing the three-sixteenth pole, steadied nearing the sixteenth marker and finished with good courage when clear. LITTLE MS PROTOCOL chased the leaders from the outside throughout and lacked the needed late response. AMAZING SAINT was bumped at the break, dueled for the lead from off the rail and gave way into the lane. A RUNNIN POP was bumped at the start, lacked early foot, saved ground throughout and failed to rally. FORGOTTEN PEOPLE raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the second turn and did not offer a bid. ESTHER CARL hesitated at the start, steadied nearing the quarter and did not menace thereafter. LIVE EVERY DAY hopped at the start, recovered quickly to duel for the early advantage from the outside and weakened after going five furlongs.
