J JETT was restless in the gate then last away, went two to three wide on the first turn, was unhurried at the rear, came under urging while three wide on the far turn, swung five wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside while lugging in and racing with her head cocked to the outside, made a bid passing the eighth-pole, battled outside in the final furlong while continuing to lug in, was nicely kept off opponents by the rider and prevailed. DAYDREAM went three then two wide on the first turn, settled just off the pace, chased three wide on the far turn, made a bid passing the five-sixteenths pole, came under the whip in upper stretch, battled gamely between horses in the final furlong and just missed. SHE'S TELLIN'TALES went four wide early on the first turn then dropped in, tracked the pace on the outside, made a bid with three furlongs to run, battled under a drive in upper stretch, fought determinedly in the final furlong but missed in a three-way photo. HOLIDAY KISS went four then three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, moved closer while four wide on the far turn, chased in upper stretch, shifted out near the furlong marker and finished willingly. LIONESS LAHR settled off the pace, moved closer late on the backstretch, was asked while off the rail near the five-sixteenths pole, chased behind horses in upper stretch and weakened. FIRST ENERGY was eager into the first turn, set the pace, lost the lead on the far turn, dropped out near the five-sixteenths pole and stopped. (Rail at 7 Feet)
