**Footnotes**

BONNIE ROSE lagged at the rear of the field, moved closer while three then four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch, shifted further to the outside of the drifting DAYDREAM, rallied under a right-handed whip into the final furlong, gained the lead near the sixteenth-pole, was given one more crack of a right-handed whip then moved clear under hand urging. SHE'S TELLIN'TALES went five wide then four wide early on the first turn, dropped to three wide late on that bend, was urged some while off the pace on the backstretch, raced three wide on the far turn, was roused passing the five-sixteenths pole, came four wide into the stretch, made a bid near the three-sixteenths pole, battled into the final sixteenth and was outfinished while drifting out but earned the place. DAYDREAM raced off the rail early on the first turn then dropped to the inside, was reserved off the pace, ranged up while three to four wide on the far turn, drifted out a few paths after turning into the stretch, made a bid in the process, battled into the final sixteenth and was also outfinished then missed the place. MISS BENBURB went four then three wide early on the first turn, dropped to one off the rail late on that bend, was reserved while a bit eager, bobbled near the three-eighths pole, moved closer while saving ground on the far turn, came out at the top of the stretch, made a bid between rivals passing the three-sixteenths pole, battled into the final sixteenth and was outkicked. HOLIDAY KISS followed the clear leader from second, moved closer while two to three wide on the far turn, made a bid inside the quarter-pole, battled into the final sixteenth and was also outkicked. LADY SCATTERLEY went three then two wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear, was roused while off the rail on the far turn and lacked the needed response. HARD POINT moved up to take the lead on the initial straightaway, went four wide into the first turn then dropped in, set the clear pace, was collared in upper stretch and gave way. REINA PLATA raced three then two wide early on the first turn, dropped to the inside late on that bend, settled off the pace, dropped to the rear leaving the backstretch and faltered.
