PIN HIGH settled off the pace off the rail, eased out with a bid leaving the seven sixteenths pole, took the lead three wide mid way on the final turn and dug in determinedly through the lane to discourage the efforts of Mr. Ripken. MR. RIPKEN rated a short lead inside, contested at even terms leaving the half mile pole, edged away from Stray Cat Jack approaching the quarter pole, was caught midway on the far turn and dug in gamely before grudgingly ceding the final yards. HIGHNTHESKYMERCURY rated well back saving ground, started a bid leaving the five sixteenths pole, steadily progressed nearest the rail rounding the final turn and dug in for a stretch long duel for show. CINDERELLA'SPALACE, well back in the three and four paths, bid leaving the three eighths pole, rounded the final turn four wide then outfinished in a stretch long duel for third. SEEKING AN EMPIRE raced in the three path the first turn, gave chase from the outside leaving the turn then leveled off six wide on the final turn. VIEWTOWN raced boxed at the rail the first turn, picked up the chase from the seven sixteenths pole, checked off the heels of Golden Punch toward the quarter pole, eased outward through the final turn, entered the stretch in the seven path then leveled off late. STRAY CAT JACK stalked the pace two deep, contested at even terms leaving the half mile pole but dropped back approaching the quarter and weakened in the stretch. GOLDEN PUNCH stalked the pace three wide, moved to even terms at the half mile pole then gave way past the three eighths.
