RUSTY RAVEN stalked the pace with good early speed while off the rail, rallied on the turn and loomed boldly, could not get by the winner and ran evenly late. DIG BLUE WATER stumbled at the start, was well placed in mid pack, ran evenly with no rally. HOPE'S FROG SONG was in a good stalking position in mid pack, ran evenly with no rally. COSIDESERVEDIT flashed brief speed chasing the pace, gave way and dropped back. SPANISH WONDER failed to menace. MISTRESS SWEET bore out at the start and then also bore out mid track on the turn, was no factor. THIS RACE WAS HAND TIMED BY A BTP EMPLOYEE.
