SNOW WAY pressed the pace three wide, made the lead on the turn, lost the lead mid stretch, came again. SWAMPOODLE moved up three and four wide, gained the lead nearing the sixteenth pole, missed in a game effort. SUAVE LASSIE advanced four and five wide, lacked a late response. DANCING WITH STARS six wide down the backstretch, dropped down three wide on the turn, never threatened in the drive. MAX'S GAL prompted the issue from the inside, swung out four wide on the turn, lacked the needed rally. VICTORY MORNING within striking distance on the rail, failed to respond. SULTRY SISTER five wide down the backstretch, was no factor. CATHERINE LIZABETH was used up after a half, four wide. SILVER VOW set the pace on the rail, stopped after a half.
