Footnotes

BEAUTIFUL BALLAD bumped lightly with a rival at the start, was taken in hand early, went four wide on the first turn, was reserved on the outside, went three to four wide on the far turn, rallied five wide into the stretch, closed strongly to make a bid at the three-sixteenths and prevailed under strong urging. DESERT RENDEZVOUS bumped lightly with a foe at the start, lugged out into the first turn, bumped with BEE BIT while swerving five wide, dropped to the four path midway through that bend, settled towards the rear, moved from the three path to the five path on the far turn, rallied seven wide into the stretch, loomed a threat behind the winner into the final furlong but couldn't get by while able to get the place. GAMBLIN TRAIN was reserved on the inside, moved to the two path inside the five-sixteenths, shifted six wide into upper stretch, drifted out near the furlong marker then was straightened by the rider and finished willingly for the show. TEMPLE CITY TERROR had the rider fall back in the saddle twice while eager into and early on the first turn, stalked the pace, made a bid in the two to three path on the far turn, led into the stretch, lost the lead while under drive near the three-sixteenths and was outfinished. STYLISH ASH was asked leaving the gate then taken in hand early, went around the first turn in the two path, settled on the backstretch, moved closer with a half-mile to run, saved ground on the far turn, came under a drive in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick. BEE BIT was bumped in the hindquarters nearing the first turn, went three then two wide on that bend, settled off the pace, moved closer near the half-mile pole, saved ground on the far turn, moved

out while put to a drive in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. FREEDOM PASSAGE was very fractious in the gate, went three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace, was asked in the two path on the far turn, chased into upper stretch and tired. RAVENEL bumped with a rival at the start, moved in at the rear, raced inside to the two path on the first turn, settled at the back, was urged along while moving from the two path to the four path on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch then moved out and failed to threaten. NERISSA went five wide on the first turn, was rated on the outside, went three to four wide on the far turn, was roused near the five-sixteenths and failed to respond. HOW DID SHE DO IT went to the front, raced in the two path early on the first turn then dropped to the inside, set the pace, was asked while inside to the two path on the far turn, was headed at the quarter-pole and gave way. ISHTAR bumped with a foe at the start, went four wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along in the two path on the far turn and faltered. (Rail at 15 Feet)
