CAPTAIN VON TRAPP, bumped at the start, settled between foes off the second flight, was steadied out of tight quarters after the opening quarter, shifted out racing into the turn while being prompted to advance, steadily gained position between foes then angled five wide racing into upper stretch and continued with a solid late response to wrest the advantage and kick clear under firm encouragement. COWBOY DIPLOMACY, off a step slowly, was roused in the opening stages to gain a contending position, advanced three deep between foes racing into the turn to challenge for command while being floated out by a drifting rival to challenge for command four deep, struck the front midstretch but proved no match for the winner while just lasting for second. CABOT settled outside foes in early stages, was fanned six wide racing into upper stretch and found his best stride late to prevail for a share. BENNY settled inside foes off the second flight in early stages, saved ground on the turn, switched out in upper stretch and improved position between rivals. ROYAL DAAHER broke inwards bumping the eventual winner, was quickly righted to join the pace three deep dictating terms on a narrow advantage racing into the turn, drifted out in upper stretch while being roused to resist a rival's challenge and proved empty in the last furlong. ATTHEPEARLYGATES, urged inside foes from the outset prompting the pace, switched off the inside racing through the turn while continuing in pursuit of the leaders but had no late response. BETTER CHARGE IT, urged between foes pressing the pace racing into the turn, duelled for command along the rail on the turn and gave way racing into upper stretch. STRONG UNION tracked off the first flight outside foes, lodged a brief bid four wide racing into the turn but soon gave way.
