ST. LOUIE GUY went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, raced four wide on the far turn, was asked outside the five-sixteenths, came five wide into the stretch under the whip and finished willingly for the show. CASSES STORY settled on the inside, saved ground through the far turn, was roused in the two path at the quarter-pole and lacked the needed kick. CURLINS VOW rounded the first turn in the two path, settled towards the rear, was urged along while three wide on the far turn and gained ground but failed to threaten. LOOKIN FOR EIGHT lost his footing at the start and broke a bit slow, saved ground on the first turn, lagged at the rear, was urged along in the two path on the turn, swung five wide into upper stretch and was no factor.
